On 14th August 2019, the Department organised a Seminar on Recent Trends in Marketing. The resource person for the day was Mr. K. Suresh Kumar, Managing Director, Biomiicron Ind.Pvt.Ltd. The Speaker gave an insight about the various trends in Marketing and with a special focus on Pharma Marketing. The Department signed an MOU with Biomiicron for various academic related activities.

The department organised a Seminar on 'Logistics as a Career' on 30th August 2019. The resource person was Mr. John Prakash, Co-founder, Director, Business School of Logistics and Shipping (BSLS).
